Bidders ***must be pre-qualified*** by the Mass DOT and approval forms submitted to the Town ***before*** bidder receives bid form.

All bids must meet the Commonwealth of Massachusetts Department of Public Works Standard Specifications for Highways, Bridges and Waterways (1988).

All contractors involved with Crack Seal shall be pre-qualified through the Massachusetts Department of Public Works, as portions of these funds are State "Chapter 90 Funds." Contractors may be pre-qualified at the Massachusetts Department of Public Works, Room 7552, 10 Park Plaza, Boston, Massachusetts 02116. Each contractor bidding on Crack Seal must submit with its bid a bid deposit equal to five percent (5%) of the amount bid. Attention is called to minimum wage rates to be paid on the work as determined by the Department of Labor Standards under the provisions of the Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 149, Section 26 to 27H inclusive. The town reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

The length of contract is from date of award to **June 30, 2018**.
