Petersham Livestock Owners

The Town of Petersham has recently appointed a new Animal Inspector. Upon review of available records, it was determined the existing list of residents owning livestock and poultry animals to be outdated and does not reflect current livestock and poultry population. Steps are being taken to update information.

In an effort to create a new and updated data base, the Inspector asks for input from the community.

Animal inspections are important in the event of a rabies or influenza outbreak, or other public health concerns that the community may need to be alerted to. Inspections help both the Town and State keep an accurate headcount.

Animal inspections will occur between September and November each year. Every effort will be made to contact animal owners via phone or email prior to each visit to establish a convenient time. It is anticipated most inspections will take 10 minutes. Your cooperation is appreciated.
