

***** RECYCLE, IT'S FREE *****

The following materials must be cleaned and placed in designated containers at the transfer station:

CO-mingle:

Numbered plastics – all numbered plastics 1-7

Glass food and beverage containers, aluminum cans and foil.

Glass jars, bottles, aluminum cans and foil can be put in same container.

Paper – Cardboard

Newsprint, junk mail, paper, hardcover books, paper bags.

Corrugated cardboard, flattened – no pizza boxes

Latex Paint – open the can; dry (kitty litter works) put with regular trash in bags

Scrap metal – scrap metal pile

Motor oil plain - bring in closed plastic containers to the Town Barn at 31 South Street.

Not allowed – plastic bags, waxed containers, Styrofoam & window glass, ceramics.

Clean returnable cans and bottles please place in Building at Transfer Station. The returnable are donated to the Raymond Scott Fund which is sponsored by The Petersham Lions Club.

Prohibited but not limited to:

Paint Thinner	Pool Chemicals	Antifreeze
Creosote	Insect Sprays	Bleaches
Solvents	Wood Strippers	Ammonia
Oil based paints	Microwave ovens	Televisions
Computer monitors	VCR's
