

The Presidential Primary will take place on Tuesday, March 3, 2020 from 7:00 AM – 8:00 PM at the Petersham Town Hall – Lower Level.

Absentee ballots are available now in the Town Clerk's Office. If you will be out of town on Election Day, if you have a disability or if you have a religious belief which prevents you from going to the polls, you qualify for an absentee ballot. Absentee ballot applications are available from the Clerk's Office or going to <https://www.sec.state.ma.us/ele/elepdf/absentee/English-Absentee-Ballot-Application.pdf>. The deadline to apply for an absentee is noon on Monday, March 2, 2020.

Early voting will be available on Monday, Feb. 24<sup>th</sup> 10am – 2 pm, Wednesday, Feb. 26<sup>th</sup> 10am – 2 pm, Thursday, Feb. 27<sup>th</sup> 3pm – 7pm and Friday, Feb. 28<sup>th</sup> 10am – 2pm in the Town Clerk's Office.
