



# Petersham Community Wood Bank Information 2018-2019

## **Voucher Information:**

Vouchers for the Town of Petersham Community Wood Bank will be available to Petersham residents starting on Monday, October 15, 2018. The vouchers may be obtained at the Town Offices, 3 South Main Street in the Selectboard's office (open Monday through Thursday 8:00 am to 5:00 pm and on Friday from 8:00 am until noon.)

The vouchers will be made available on a first come, first served basis but with priority given to residents receiving fuel assistance. Vouchers will be issued for one (1) crate of dry, split & stacked wood stored at the Transfer Station (open every Saturday from 9:00 am until 2:00 pm). One voucher per household may be applied on a monthly basis if needed and as supplies last.

## **Wood Status:**

The moisture content of the wood is monitored by representatives of DCR and the Petersham Tree Warden to ensure that only suitably dry wood is safe for release. Each numbered crate of wood will be tagged with colored flagging tape: green = good to go, red = still too wet. To confirm that your crate of wood is ready please either check at the Transfer Station yourself or contact:

## **Pick up of wood:**

Wood may be picked up at the Transfer Station (route 122) beginning on Saturday, November 3, 2018. Simply bring your voucher and give it to the Transfer Station attendant. Each voucher will have a number that corresponds to a numbered crate. Load up your wood! Please try to remove your wood within a three week time period after voucher issuance.
